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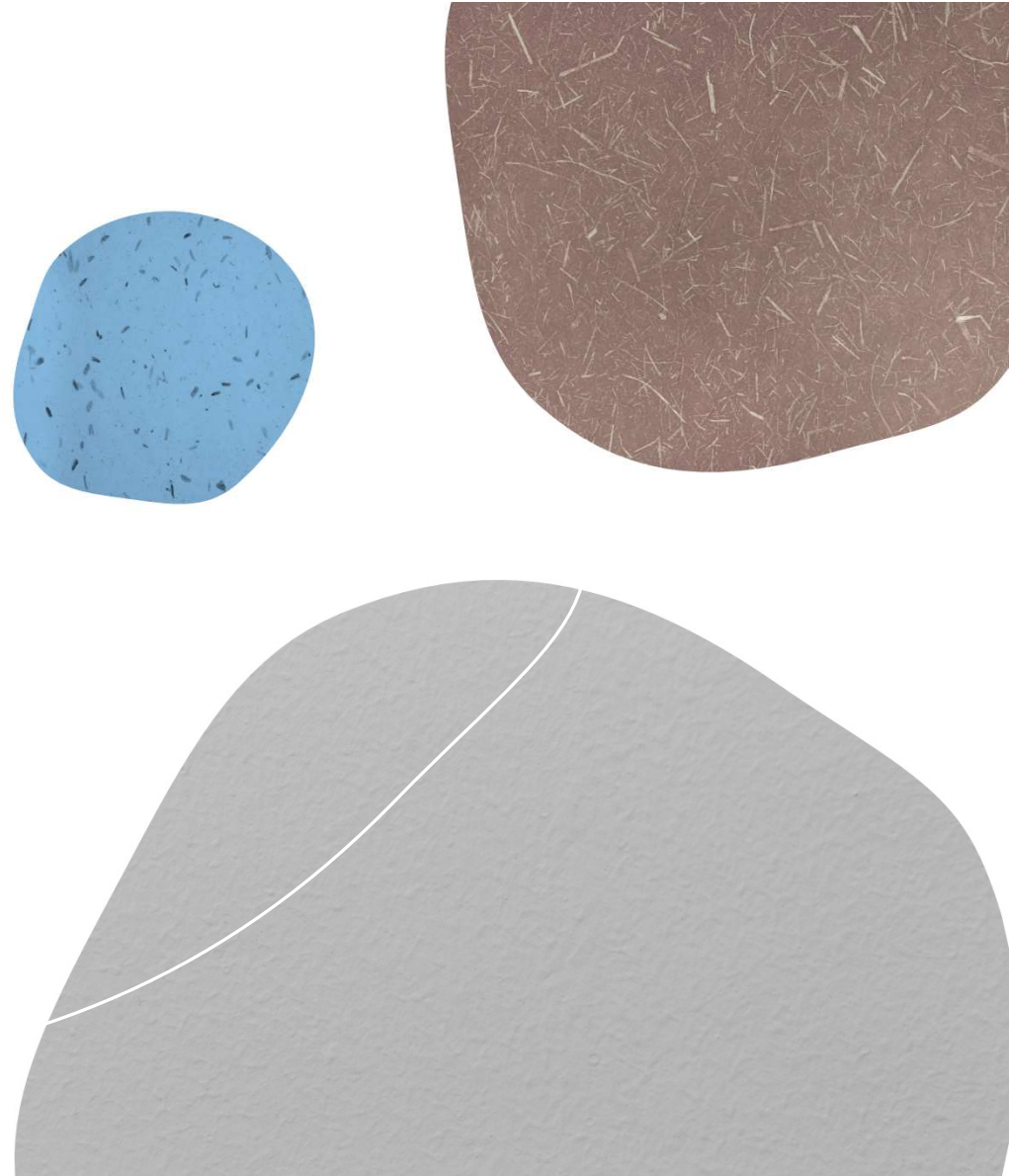

What is a Breakout Box?

Breakout boxes are game based activities that encourage collaboration and test students' critical thinking skills based on certain subject content. Usually involves multiple steps and solving clues to unlock containers.

What it should be:

- Fun
- Challenging
- A way to test critical thinking
- A way to test content knowledge
- A way to encourage collaboration with classmates
- Additional way to introduce or review information

What it shouldn't be:

- Something you spend all your time creating
- A way to just fill time
- Use for every lesson or unit.
- Your only source of review or introduction to information.
- Impossible to complete.



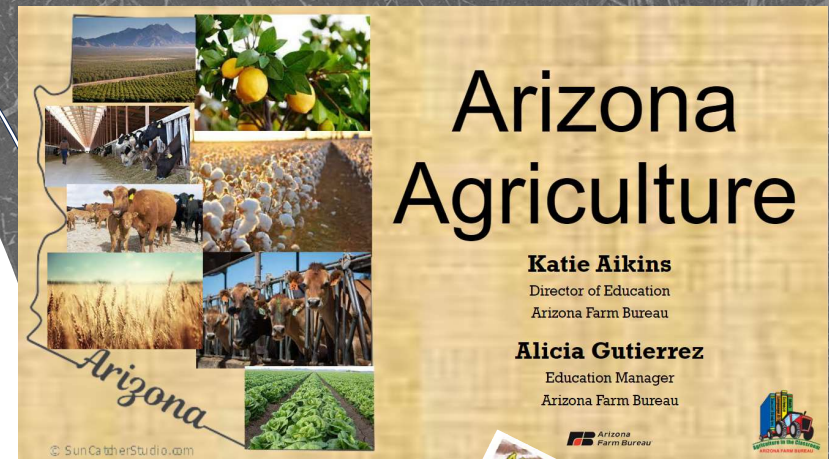
When to use them?

Review of a topic

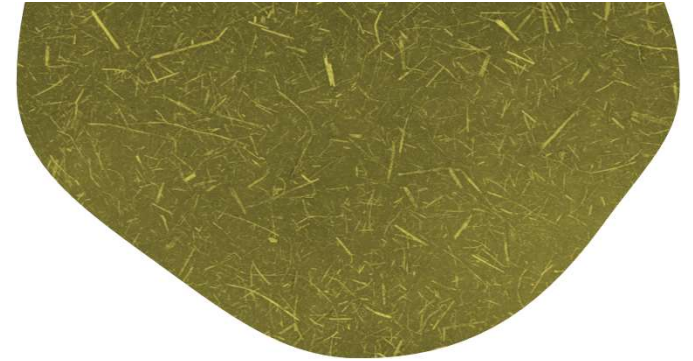
With a written text

At an event/booth

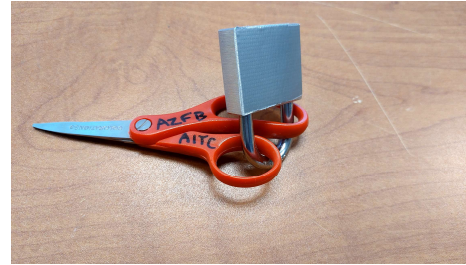


Common Mistakes

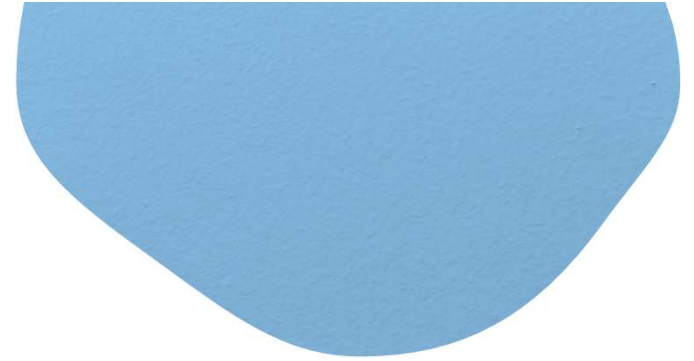
